

Bagging Policy
(updated 3/11/14)

In an effort to accommodate all students interested in bagging, the following policy has been updated and subsequently approved by the Executive Board. The following are effective immediately:

1. Each student will work a 2 hour shift. There are 20 spots per bagging.
2. Sign ups will be at the parent meeting at least one month prior to the bagging date (example: sign up for the January bagging will be at the December meeting). If you do not attend the parent meeting you can email the chair person your request to sign up for bagging that month after the date has been announced at the meeting.
3. Students will be selected via a 'rotating lottery system'. For example, if more than 20 students sign up, any student who bagged in the prior month will be placed on the waiting list for bagging in the next month.
4. If your student has signed up for bagging, you must be available to chaperone a 2-hour bagging shift.
5. In cases where siblings are scheduled on the same date, they will be scheduled on the same shift.
6. After sign ups are concluded, an email will be sent to verify your student's time slot. If you do not respond to this email by the deadline set forth, your student's assigned spot will be reassigned to someone on the waiting list.
7. At least one week prior to the bagging date a final bagging schedule will be emailed out to those who are bagging that month.
8. If you cannot make the scheduled bagging time slot please call the chair person and let them know as soon as possible. We understand emergencies happen, but we request the courtesy of a phone call. If your student is scheduled to bag and simply does not show up for his/her bagging shift – the student will not be eligible to bag for the rest of the band season!
9. After the bagging deposit is made, the chair person will email you on how much will be added to your personal account.
10. The chair person's information will be on the website and in the emails sent by her/him.
11. Students must wear tan or black pants, red band polo shirt and closed shoes. The use of cell phones or any electronic device while bagging is not permitted. Drinks or food are not allowed at the register. Students may not chew gum while bagging. These fundraisers are very important and we need to keep them. Please remind your child to act appropriately while bagging. Thank you and a smile go a long way 😊
